## **CiTR is looking for a volunteer News Director!**

Our current director Morgan Yee is leaving us in December 2014. We are looking for a dedicated individual to join the team in September, working alongside Morgan as co-director and taking over as director in December.

### **Requirements:**

- Commitment to the position for the full term (Dec - April)
- Available during the News 101 programming slot (Fridays 5-6, Mondays pending)
- Facilitate weekly meetings with news volunteers and contributors to plan programming
- Develop content and assist with the show through hosting or producing when necessary
- Respond to emails in a timely manner, passing on leads to team members when appropriate
- Engage with other members and staff at CiTR to work towards integrating news content into daily programming

\* The News Director has historically worked with a CiTR volunteer with a disability who otherwise would not have access to programming - over the past 2 years this individual has produced 3 radio documentaries: one on animal rights, on HandyDart services, and on accessibility concerns/the importance of having voice. Timelines are organized at the director & volunteer's discretion.

Students who possess self-motivation, team leadership skills, and problem-solving, as well as a keen analytical mind and an eye for a great news story will do very well in this position - bonus points if you have any relevant experience in journalism or radio broadcasting!

CiTR's news team is a great place to get more experience with broadcast journalism, conducting interviews, and team leadership skills. As director, you will have a great deal of flexibility in what kinds of projects are taken on - for example, this year the team produced an episode of Groundwire, a nationally-broadcast news show. We hope that next year News 101's presence will continue to grow both at CiTR, locally, and nationally.
