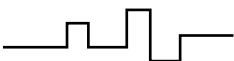


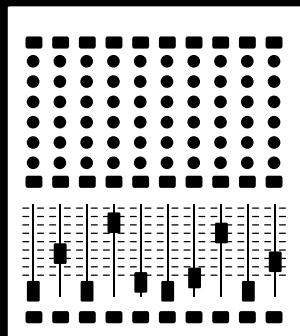
Dear CiTR members, volunteers, programmers, friends and supporters,

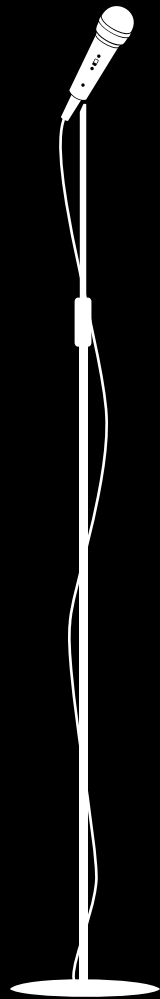

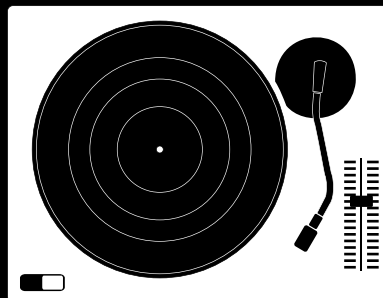

March 16, 2009, Julie Dioron visited CiTR for a special edition of Live From Thunderbird Radio Hell to play songs from her newest album, I Can Wonder What You Did With Your Day.

On Jan 17, 2009, CiTR led another year of 24 Hours of Radio Art with help from other stations.

CiTR's first Show Swap occurred July 21-27, with programmers trading shows, and testing their chops at programming new topics and genres.

CiTR hosted a live broadcast of the Welcome Back BBQ at UBC, giving our listeners a chance to hear The Clips, No Gold and Matinee live. We were also backstage at the AMS Block Party interviewing Tokyo Police Club and the Roots.

On December 5, 2008, Discorder celebrated its 25th birthday with a karaoke party at Hoko's Sushi.

CiTR commissioned its first ever BBM (Bureau of Broadcast Management) listenership survey. The station learned that it has over 14,400 listeners on average per week, and a market share of 0.5%, the same as Radio-Canada.

The Friends of CiTR Card is expanding! All members are now given a complimentary Friends card and the list of businesses has grown to 26.

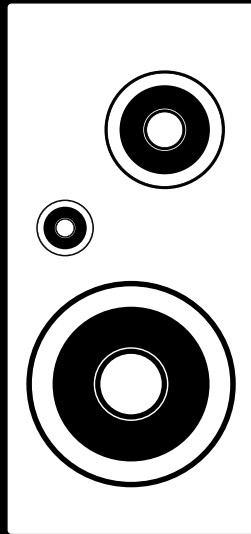
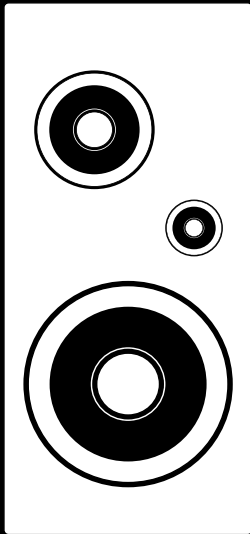

@CiTR1019, a twitter account for CiTR related information, was created during this year's Fundrive in an effort to utilize social media to connect listeners to the station.

Since ProfTalk debuted on CiTR in November 2008, 30 guests have appeared on the show from over 18 different faculties/schools/departments on campus. ProfTalk has now appeared in over 15 web pages; podcasts have been uploaded to individual faculty/department websites as well as on several online UBC magazines/newsletters, strengthening the connection between CiTR and UBC.

Becky Sandler, CiTR's promotions director, started a street team that provided the man and woman -power to up our partnerships with local venues.

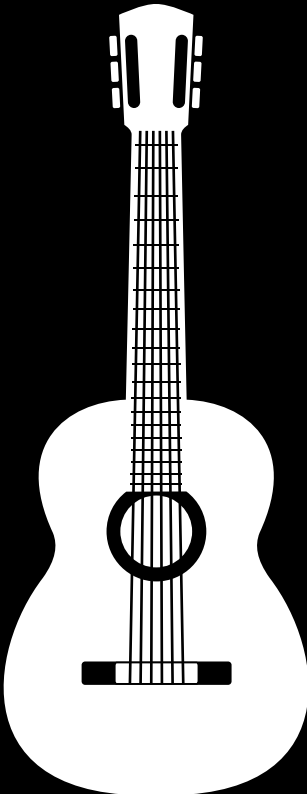

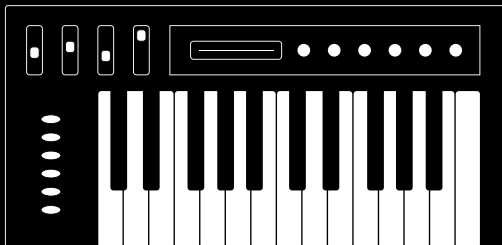

Fundraiser puts CiTR solidly in the black

Listeners seem to like what they're hearing

THIS YEAR'S fundraising efforts by UBC's "own BBC" more than doubled last year's take, according to station manager Brenda Grunau.

Instead of simply meeting CiTR's goal of \$11,000, the 101.9 FM listeners—some from as far away as Bowen Island, Bellingham, and Nelson—pledged over \$18,000 during a two-week on-air pledge drive. A "Fundrive Finale Party" filled the Biltmore Cabaret Nov. 29 for performances by local bands such as the Burnley Claps and the National Shack, as well as an appearance by comedian Graham Clark.

Money raised that night included a contribution from the bar's owner, Zak Pashak, who offered to match the night's donations. The grand total: \$21,893.

"We are completely amazed by the generosity of our donors," Grunau wrote in an email. "Our goal was \$15,000 (because we thought we could reach it) but the support from the Vancouver community has blown us away. The money is much needed, and will support our programming and enable us to purchase equipment for our studios."

The station operates on a budget of \$285,000, a portion of which comes from student activity fees. "That isn't quite enough for us," said Grunau.

The rest, she said, comes from advertising from local businesses, merchandise sales, DJ services, merchandise and fundraising.

The station operates on volunteer labour, with disc jockeys and show programmers contributing their time and skills. "That means the content is all provided by people from the community," said Grunau. "We don't tell the programmers what to play. They make those choices themselves, within CRTC guidelines." Prospective DJs submit a demo and go through training. They can pitch a show as long as it doesn't repeat an existing program.

The station's licence includes regulations that it must serve diverse and niche populations. The station broadcasts shows in Italian, Spanish, Farsi, and Russian. Besides music, the station has shows on comedy and graphic novels, comedy, alternative news and sex.

The DJs and staff aren't necessarily UBC students. Grunau did a master's degree in arts management in Toronto. Radio program host Liam John "Tensec" who mixes vintage rock 'n' roll with newer bands like Radiohead and Dead Can Dance on alternating Mondays between 6 and 7:30 p.m., came to the station following a decade-spanning career in commercial radio.

The 65-year-old Kelowna-based DJ's resume is an alphabet soup of call letters: he has worked at CFUN, CKIC, CKVN, CJOR, CHEX, and CFML. He was at a Langley station when radio programmer David Marsden "took the place over" and turned into alternative-music station Coast 100, which later became Coast 1040. It shut down in 1993.

"That was my last commercial gig,"

said Tensec. "I was really frustrated for a few years not doing radio. My wife said, 'Why don't you try to get something at CiTR?'"

Tensec doesn't miss his commercial counterparts. "I really just enjoy doing this. You can play what you want, as long as you play your Canadian content."

For the pledge drive, many of the DJs brought in guests and gave out their own prizes, such as mix CDs, to go with the CiTR T-shirt giveaways. Julia Saunders, who co-hosts *Fairfax Radio* Wednesday nights at 10 p.m. with Caroline MacGillivray, says they offered as prizes many of the sexuality-oriented books they've received in the last several months.

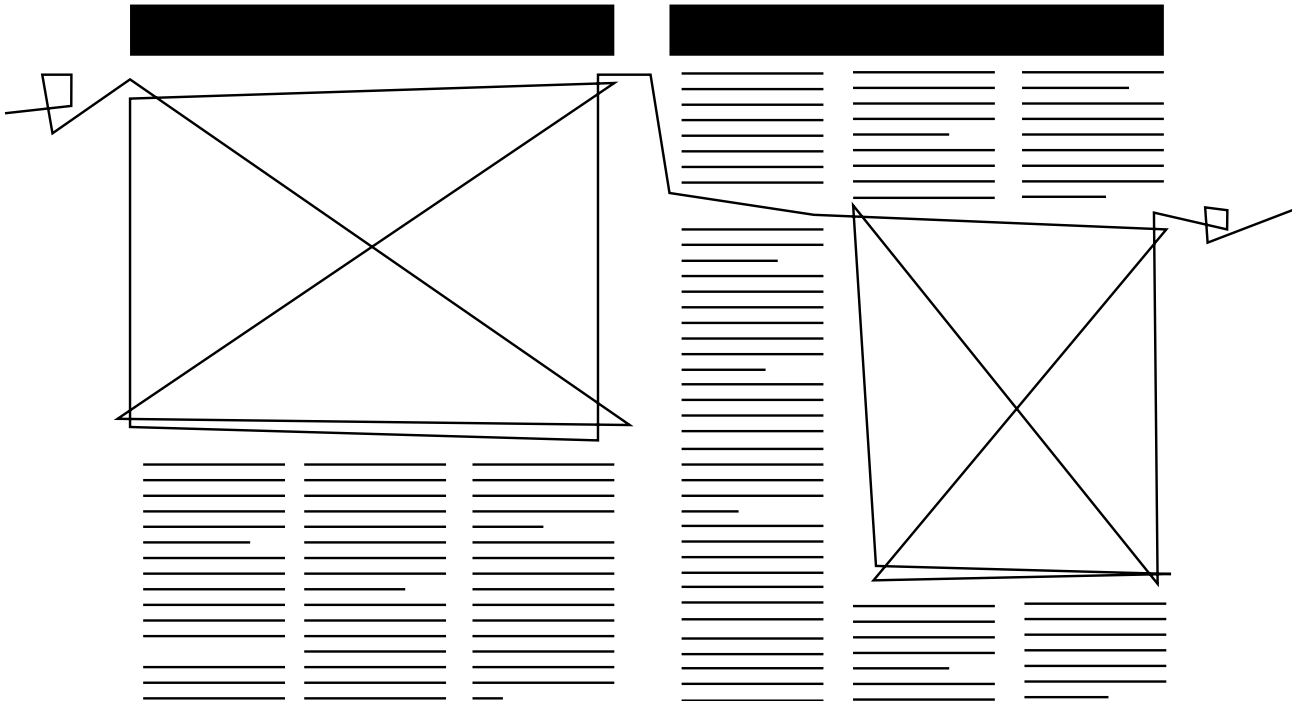
They also gave out tickets to the new movie *60/40*, about San Francisco gay activist Harvey Milk. Instead of their usual programming, such as interviewing an author or sex specialist or sharing their thoughts on a topic, Saunders and MacGillivray read pieces of erotica.

"Campus and community radio is totally invaluable in giving a broad representation of what's actually happening ethnically and culturally and politically," said Saunders, who's been hosting her show for five years.

"It's really in the trenches. It comes from young people who are excited about making a difference in the world, and they find all this information and music, and put it all out there in ways that commercial radio can't, or won't. It's our own BBC."

But as Janet Forsyth told the Straight the switchover was an amiable one: "Nobody might have noticed." Javel's changing, really she said. "The booking policy is the same, the staff is the same. We have two people taking over the management from my brother and I, but other than that, nothing's changing." 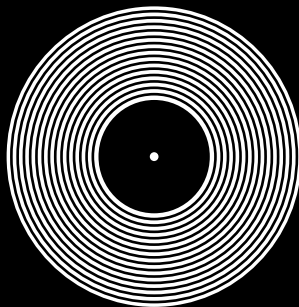

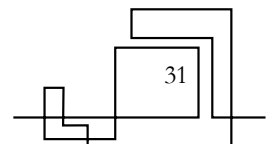
