The Web Editor will ensure that content is created consistently throughout the year and ensure that Discorder content is featured prominently online.

The ideal candidate will be motivated, creative and organized with an ability to set and keep deadlines. The successful candidate will have strong writing and communication skills, copyediting or editing experience preferred.
